

## **Bookmaker Applications**

The minimum age for a Bookmaker fielding at Thoroughbred Race meetings is 21 years, for Harness and Greyhounds 18 years.

Applicants should have approximately 6 months experience as a Bookmakers' Clerk or have previously worked as a Licensed Bookmaker.

Applications for membership of the NSW Bookmakers' Co-operative Limited should be accompanied by two passport type photographs.

On completion of the application form, please contact the Co-operative for an appointment for an interview by the Credentials Committee. At the interview you will be required to show the following proof of assets and cash as stated on pages 4 and 5 of the application form, for example: -

1. Bank/Building Society statements showing all entries for the preceding six months.
2. Copy of Title deeds to all property shown.
3. If property is mortgaged, a letter from the mortgagee supplying: -
  - (a) particulars of property
  - (b) name of owner
  - (c) outstanding balance of loan account.
4. Documentary evidence of other assets shown.

It is a condition that guarantees issued on behalf of new members of the Co-operative to controlling authorities must be fully supported by means of one of the following: -

- i. Registered mortgage.
  - ii. Cash deposit.
  - iii. Bank guarantee.
